	<u>Legislation</u>	Action
HB16-1001	State Contractors Compliance with Equal Pay Laws.	passed the House; awaiting action in the Senate, but assigned to the "kill committee" there
HB16- 1045	Starting the Child Tax Credit	killed in the House Finance Committee, because of the cost.
HB16- 1066	Habitual Domestic Violence Offenders	passed the House and Senate; awaiting the Governor's signature.
HB16- 1072	No Statute of Limitations on Sexual Assault	killed in the House Judiciary Committee, at the sponsor's request
